REGULATIONS made by the Minister responsible for gaming in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by section 24 of the Gaming Control Act, Chapter 152 of the Substantive Laws of Belize, Revised Edition, 2000-2003 and all other powers thereunto him enabling.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the

Short title.

**GAMING CONTROL (GAMING MACHINES)
(AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 2011,**

and shall be read and construed as one with the Gaming Control (Gaming Machines) Regulations, 2003, which as amended, are hereinafter referred to as the principal Regulations.

2. Regulation 5 of the principal Regulations is hereby amended as follows:-

“ (2) An application under this regulation shall be accompanied by a non-refundable application fee set out in the Third Schedule to these Regulations.”

(b) by repealing subregulation (4) thereof (added by statutory instrument No. 74 of 2007) and replacing it by the following:-

“ (4) Where the Board approves the application there shall be payable to the Board a license fee set out in the Third Schedule to these Regulations.”

3. Regulation 7 of the principal Regulations is hereby amended by repealing sub regulation (1) thereof (added by Statutory Instrument No. 74 of 2007) and replacing it by the following:

S.I. 74/2007. “ (1) A License issued under these Regulations shall be valid from the date of issue to 31st March next ensuing and may be renewed upon payment of the annual renewal fee per gaming machine set out in the Third Schedule to these Regulations.”

4. The principal Regulations are hereby amended by the addition of the Schedule annexed hereto as the “Third Schedule” to these Regulations.

5. These Regulations shall come into force on **1st April, 2011.**
